


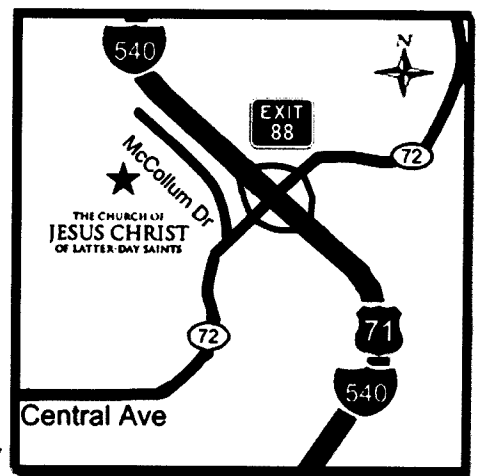

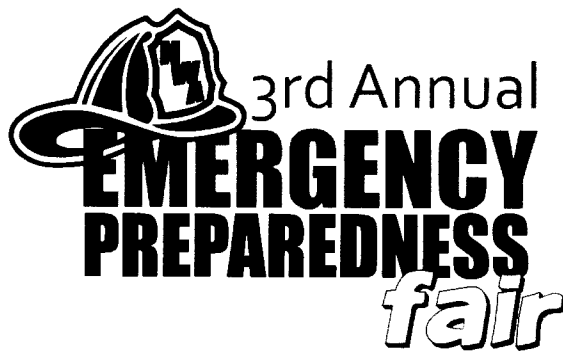

- The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Emergency Preparedness Fair will take place **Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009 from 10 am to 3 pm** at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints at 1101 McCollum Dr. in Bentonville.
- FREE lunch will be provided for all attendees from 11 am to 2 pm
- FREE 72-Hour Starter Kits will be given to the first 1,000 families in attendance and there will be drawings for door prizes
- FREE Child ID Kits will be made for the first 1,000 children, including photograph, fingerprinting and DNA (hair) sample.
- 50+ Booths will provide information on Creating 72-hour kits, Personal and Child Safety, Creating Family Emergency Plans, Storm Shelters, Severe Weather Information, Electrical Outages and Safety, Water Purification and Storage, Emotional Support and Help Information, Fire Prevention, Basic Food and Water Storage, and many more.
- Over 100 experts will be present to teach about a range of emergency preparedness topics.
- The American Red Cross will host a blood drive at the Fair.
- Channel 40/29 and KNWA weather teams will talk about preparing for severe weather conditions.
- Family activities at the Fair will include the Bentonville Fire Department Smokehouse, a showcase of Emergency and First Response vehicles, a ReadyKids Kids Corner with coloring and other preparedness-focused activities, a bounce house, balloons, visits from Dora the Explorer and Shrek characters, a free Lowe's Children's Clinic and more.
